



The Impact of Health on Retirement Decision of Canadian Nikpoor SOMAIEH

This paper investigates the impact of socio-economical variables, specifically health status of individuals on the retirement decision in Canada. The General Social Survey Cycle16 (GSS16): Aging and Social Support for 2002, has been used to assess the impact of health on retirement. The multinomial probit estimation shows that the health status of the individuals can affect their retirement decision significantly; however individuals' wealth still has the largest effect on their retirement decisions.
